"FROM GRIEF TO NEW HOPE" 8-WEEK WORKSHOP


is a workshop that combines the educational components of a seminar with the safety and support of a peer group. Offered in-person and virtually, this workshop serves adults who are grieving the death of a loved one.

Each session begins with a speaker. Participants then break into small groups according to their loss. The groups, led by peer support facilitators, provide a safe space for participants to express their grief and begin healing.

THE IMPACT

- While New Hope continues to serve participants for lossspecific grief, we have seen continued growth in workshop attendance for complicated or traumatic grief including death due to suicide and substance use. 23% of this year's participants experienced this form of loss.
- Individuals who have lost a loved one are reaching out to New Hope for support earlier than ever before. 70% of participants experienced their loss less than six months prior to attending a workshop.

HOPE FOR THE HOLIDAYS SEMINAR






