Soccer



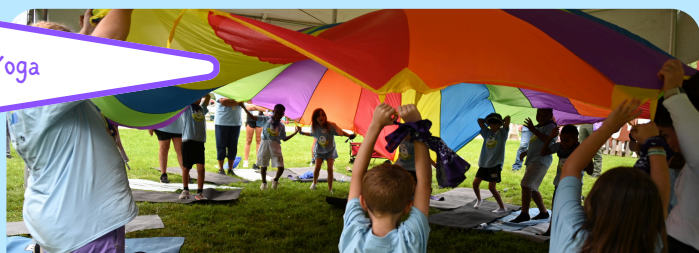
With Michigan Jaguars FC, campers learned the importance of teamwork to overcome challenges. They also were taught some new soccer techniques.

Songwriting



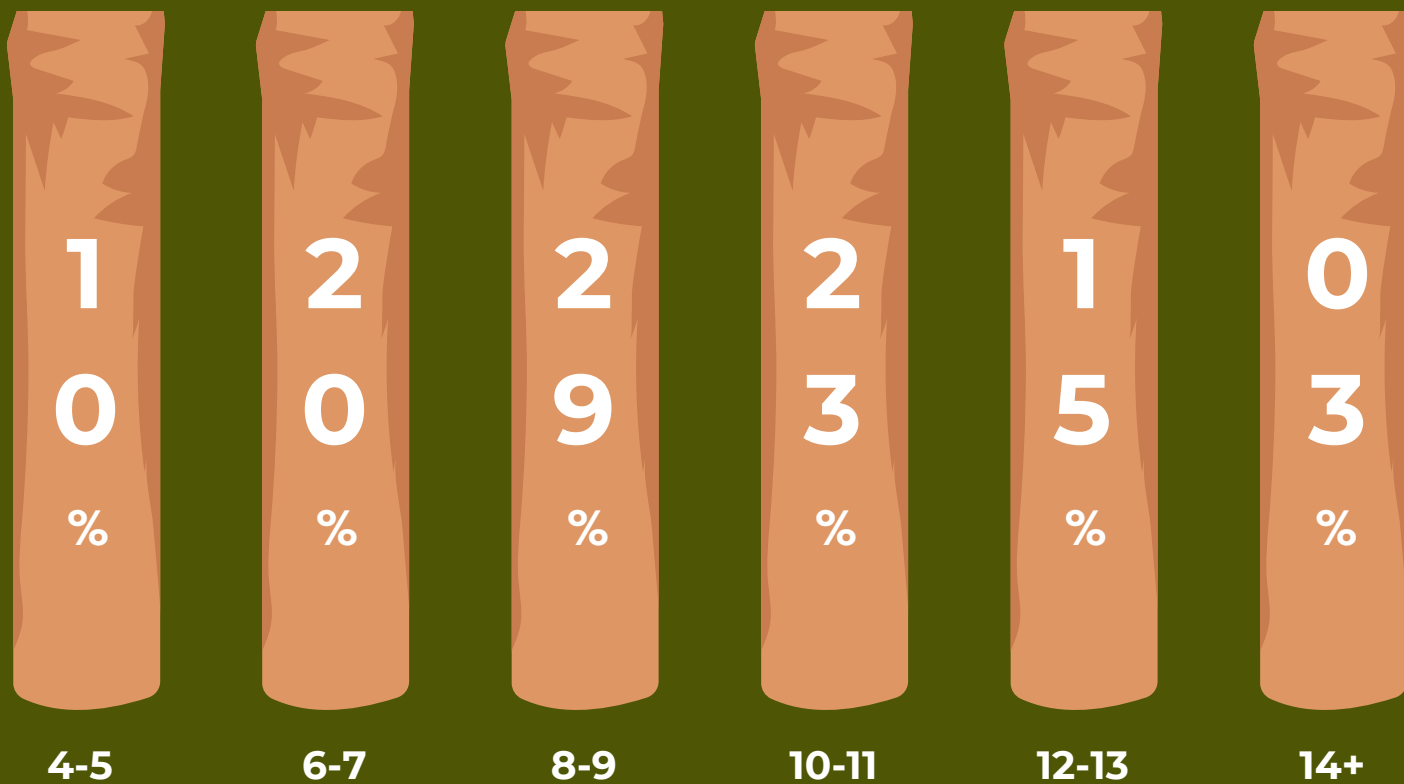
With Lost Voices, campers wrote and recorded a song to describe their experience with grief. Each group had the opportunity to create their own verse!

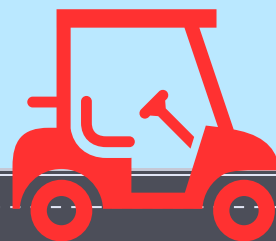
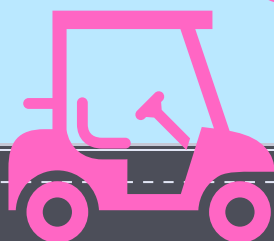

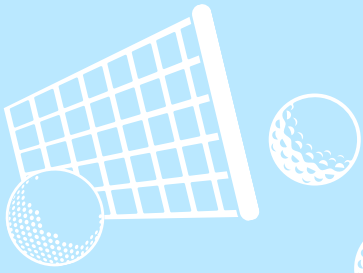
