<u>Description:</u> "From Grief to New Hope" Eight-Week Workshop combines the educational components of a seminar with the safety of a peer group. This workshop is available to adults who are grieving the death of a loved one. It provides a safe place to express grief and begin the healing process. Each session includes a speaker, and then participants are placed into small groups according to their type of loss.

This one-time scheduled meeting provides an opportunity to connect with one of our facilitators that is close in age and has experienced a similar type of loss.

<u>Description:</u> Our ongoing peer grief support groups meet on a regular basis throughout the year. We are seeking individuals and organizations willing to commit to a monthly donation or a one-time gift to help cover the costs of our ongoing support groups. These include groups for spouse loss, child loss, teen group, loss due to suicide, substance use, and a group for all losses. New Hope currently offers 16 different ongoing grief support groups.

July 25-July 26, 2024



Our camp allows bereaved children ages 4-14, to learn about grief, achieve opportunities to learn about the reactions and emotions associated with grief, the significance of developing healthy coping skills, and ways to grow through the grief journey by sharing stories and building a strong community.

In 2023 we had our highest attendance ever of 117, and we are anticipating 150 in 2024.

<u>Description:</u> This program is designed for students that are grieving the death of a loved one. Our program will help students better understand their grief, provide a safe space for them to communicate their thoughts and feelings, provide them with healthy coping skills, and the tools they will need to help them navigate their grief journey. This school-based program provides two days of personal development grief sensitivity training to school staff and administration, and two 8-week teen support group sessions per year.
